The shelter is on the N.W. corner of County Farm & Manchester Rds., ½ mile north of Roosevelt.

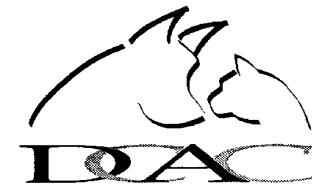

What does Dupage County Animal Care & Control do?

DCAC is a self-supporting county department designed to:

- Prevent and control rabies through bite investigation and rabies registration
- Enforce state and county animal control and welfare laws
- Operate a shelter for stray and owner-relinquished pets
- Adopt unwanted animals to responsible homes
- Promote responsible pet ownership and animal welfare through counseling and law enforcement
- Rescue animals that are lost, diseased, injured, or in peril
- Provide public education programs for schools and group organizations

What Volunteer Opportunities are available?

- Animal Care

This position involves cleaning, feeding, watering, grooming and walking shelter animals. All positions require some training.

- Clerical Duties

This involves assisting office staff with various clerical duties.

- Pet Therapy

Assist staff members by taking selected adoption animals to various convalescent centers to visit with the residents.

- Assistant Trainer

Assisting in operation of dog obedience training classes, working with shelter animals to optimize adoption potential.

- Foster Kitten Program
You would agree to care for newborn kittens off-premises. This position requires a great deal of time and you would be responsible for the cost of the care.

Anyone under 16 years of age would need to have an adult volunteer with them any time that they are here.
