Wheaton, IL – DuPage County Animal Care & Control will host the 5th Annual Multi-Shelter Pet Expo on Saturday, May 12, 2007 at the DCACC shelter located at 120 N. County Farm Rd. in Wheaton. The Multi-Shelter Pet Expo will feature more than 50 animal welfare/adoption agencies and breed-specific rescue groups showcasing animals presently available for adoption.

Animals up for adoption at the expo include dogs, cats and small animals (rabbits, hamsters, guinea pigs.)
