DuPage County has amended the above Action Plan and Consolidated Plan for the purpose of fulfilling the application requirements to receive funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) authorized under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). DuPage County will be receiving approximately \$1,433,723 in Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing (HPRP) funds. The County intends to utilize these funds for homelessness prevention and rapid re-housing programs including financial assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services for income-eligible residents of the County and for eligible administrative and data collection and evaluation costs, as follows: Prairie State Legal Services (Legal Services Related to Rental Housing) \$68,500; DuPage Homeownership Center (Credit Repair) \$68,500; DuPage County Community Services (Homeless Management Information Systems (“HMIS”) Data Collection and Evaluation) \$50,000; DuPage County Community Services Housing Quality Standards (“HQS”) (Inspection of Units) \$14,000; Catholic Charities, Diocese of Joliet (Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing) \$285,281; DuPage County Community Services (Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing) \$309,566; Hinsdale Community Services (Homelessness Prevention Services) \$150,000; Outreach Community Ministries (Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing) \$128,719; People’s Resource Center (Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing) \$315,845; and administration \$43,312.
