

EMERGENCY NUMBERS AND SERVICES

**For police, fire or
ambulance emergencies**

Dial “911”



The use of “911” is no longer restricted to emergencies. “911” should be used by any citizen in DuPage County to access the police or fire department for any kind of service other than information. A trained dispatcher will identify your concern or problem and send the appropriate help. **If in doubt, dial “911”.**

DIAL “0”

Where “911” is not available (some areas outside DuPage County), dial “0” for operator assistance. Tell the operator the type of emergency, and the exact address and town where help is needed.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL HELP

In the event of a medical emergency, it is vital to seek medical help right away. DIAL “911” or the telephone operator “0” if necessary. Some insurance companies require certain protocol before hospital admission. Before an emergency occurs, familiarize yourself with your insurance company’s pre-admission policy.
