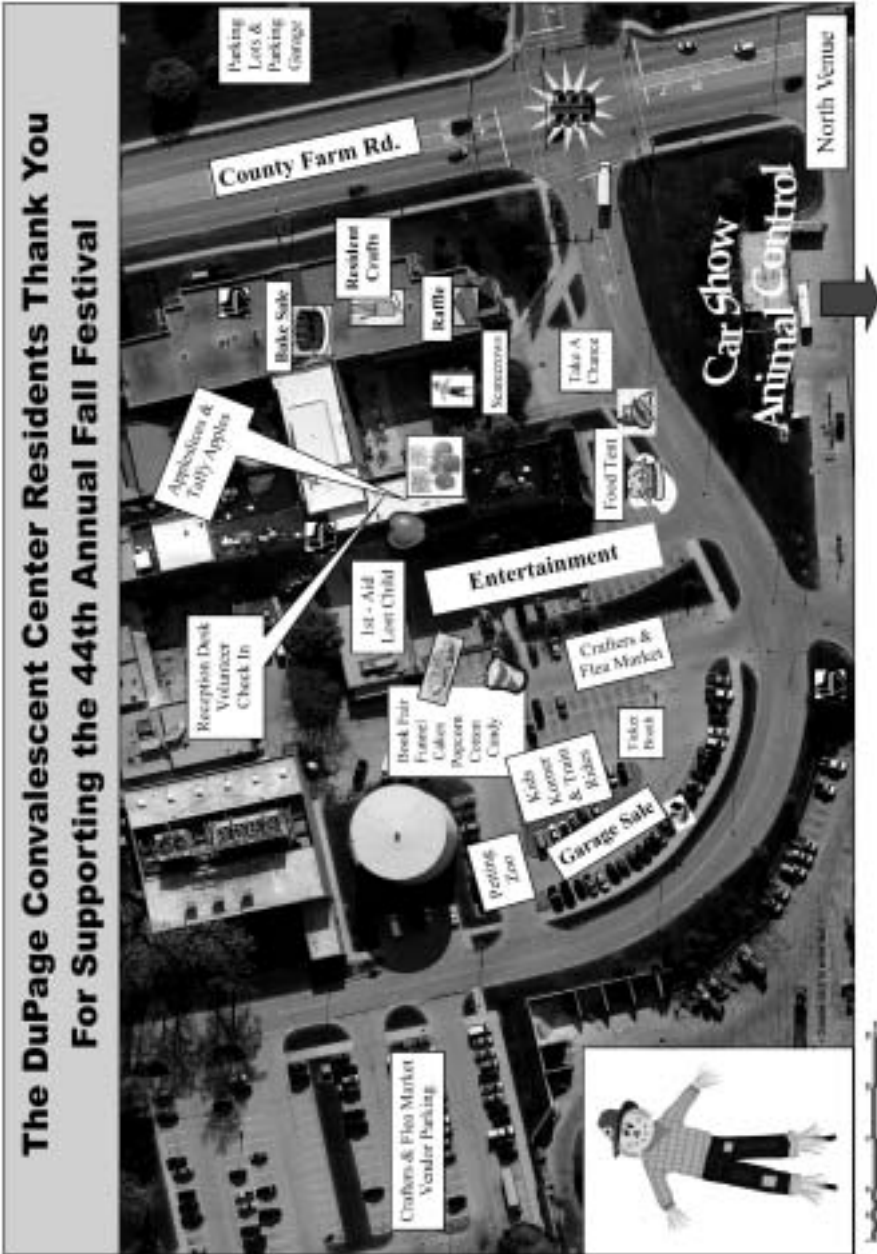

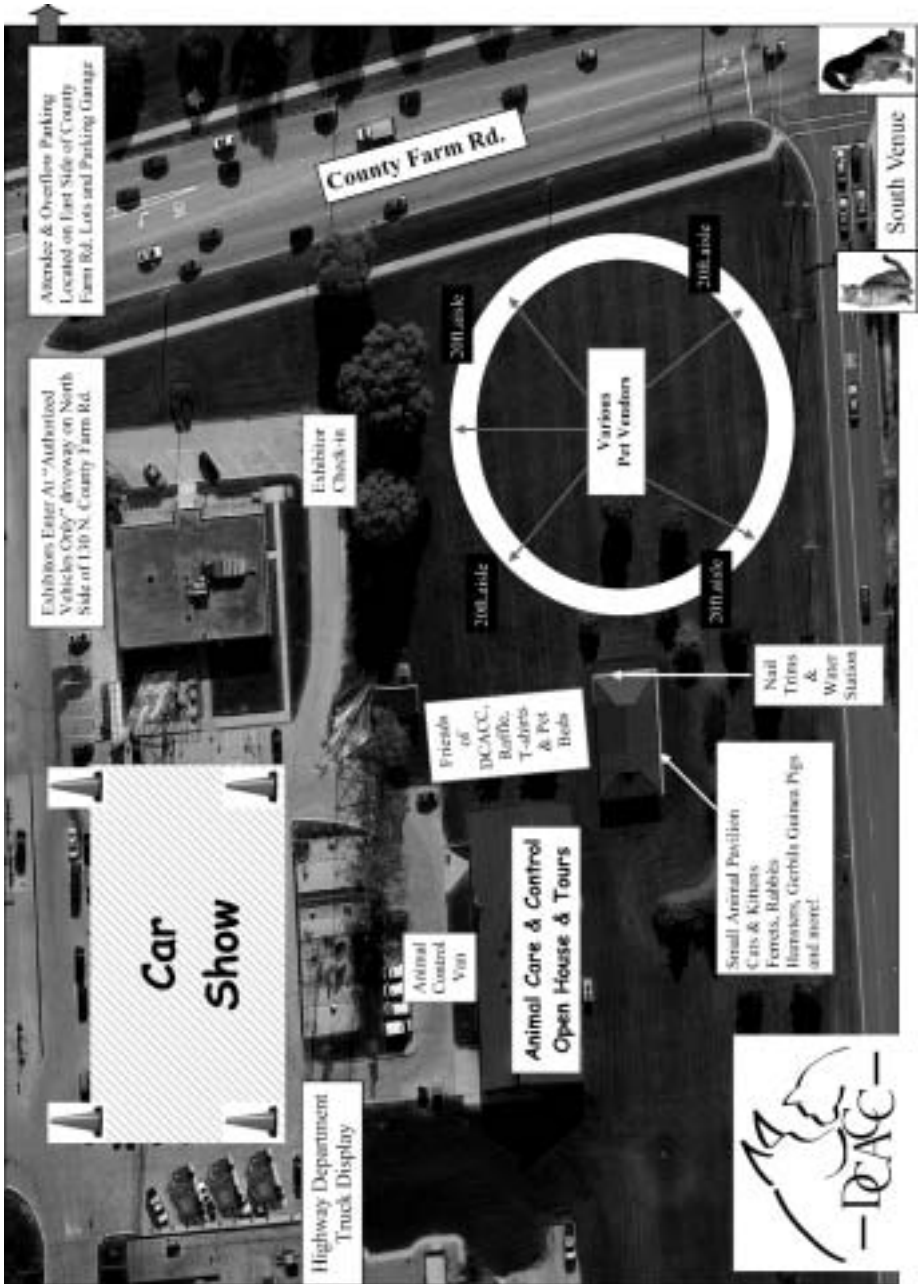
Festival Map North Venue

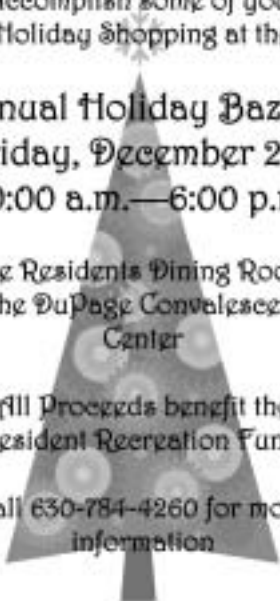

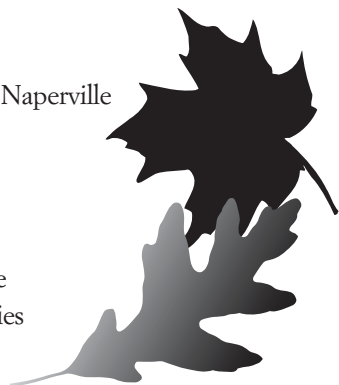

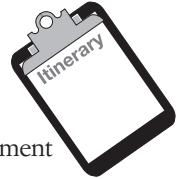
