IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, pursuant to Illinois Supreme Court Order M.R. 30370 effective April 3rd, 2020 (see attached), the Chief Judge orders that all trials may be continued until further order of the Illinois Supreme Court. In the case of criminal proceedings, any delay resulting from this emergency continuance order shall not be attributable to either the State or the defendant for purposes of section 103-5 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 (725 ILCS 5/103-5 (West 2018)). In the case of juvenile delinquency proceedings, any delay resulting from this emergency continuance order shall not be attributable to either the State or the juvenile for purposes of section 5-601 of the Illinois Juvenile Court Act (705 ILCS 405/5-601 (West 2018)).

This Administrative Order authorizes the Judges of the 18th Judicial Circuit to continue trials pursuant to the above-referenced Illinois Supreme Court Order as deemed necessary.

This Administrative Order supersedes Administrative Order 20-9.
