the Coronavirus (COVID-19) )

**WHEREAS**, due to the frequently changing circumstances involved with the COVID-19 pandemic, measures must continue to be implemented and updated to both protect the health and safety of all those working inside the courthouse and the public, and to ensure the fair and efficient access to justice; and,

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Order 20-20 effective May 1, 2020 rescheduled most Felony, Misdemeanor, Juvenile and Traffic matters scheduled on or between May 18-June 5, 2020 for a period of at least 28 days from their originally scheduled court dates; and,

**WHEREAS**, after extensive discussion and collaboration with justice system partners and stakeholders, the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit will implement a gradual and phased plan to resume court business beginning June 8, 2020 using both remote technology and conducting in-person proceedings with certain limitations; and,

**WHEREAS**, Village of Addison officials have closed their traffic court facility for the foreseeable future due to health and safety concerns related to COVID-19; and,


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to relocate and reschedule matters assigned to the Addison traffic court for the foreseeable future.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that:

- All matters currently assigned into Addison traffic court and scheduled for a court date on or between June 8 and July 2, 2020 are hereby rescheduled by the Circuit Court Clerk into the courthouse at 505 N. County Farm Road, Wheaton, with notice sent by mail to all interested parties.
- All rescheduled Addison traffic court matters will be heard in the annex meeting room on the first floor of the courthouse at either 10:00 A.M. or 2 P.M. Monday through Friday.
- No witnesses or police officers are required to appear in court on the rescheduled cases. Anyone seeking a trial will receive a future court date and all witnesses will be notified for trial.

- Effective immediately, all future Addison traffic court citations should continue to reflect the court location as 3 Friendship Plaza, Addison, and court times as either 8:30 A.M. or 1:00 P.M. If necessary, the Circuit Court Clerk will again reschedule traffic court matters with a notice sent by mail to all interested parties.
