**DUPAGE COUNTY TRAFFIC COURTS TO**  
**REMAIN CLOSED THROUGH JANUARY 15<sup>TH</sup>**  
**DUE TO COVID-19**

DuPage County Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin announced today that due to the ongoing and significant increase in COVID-19 cases throughout the State of Illinois and DuPage County, he has issued an Administrative Order directing that all matters scheduled for traffic court on or between January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021 and January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021 be rescheduled to a future court date by the Circuit Court Clerk. These matters will be reset to a future court date at least 28 days from their current court date. The rescheduled dates can be viewed by attorneys at [eaccess.18thjudicial.org](http://eaccess.18thjudicial.org) (eaccess) and the general public at [epay.18thjudicial.org](http://epay.18thjudicial.org) (epay). The Clerk will also send notice via mail to all interested parties.

As a result of rescheduling these matters, all traffic courts will remain closed through January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021. "In order to protect the health and safety of court employees and the general public, we decided that keeping the traffic courts closed through January 15<sup>th</sup> was the responsible and prudent step to take in response to the continued increase in COVID-19 cases. We will continue to closely monitor the situation and follow the guidance provided by the CDC, IDPH and DuPage County Health Department." said Chief Judge Daniel P. Guerin.
