REMOVAL OF SEAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Director of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, John J. Kim, pursuant to Section 34(b) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/34(b) (2018), with regard to this Seal Order entered on February 15, 2019.

THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY HEREBY FINDS THAT:

1. On September 6, 2019, Judge Paul M. Fullerton entered the proposed Consent Order in the case of People of the State of Illinois, ex rel. Kwame Raoul, Attorney General, and ex rel. Robert Berlin, DuPage County State's Attorney, v. Sterigenics U.S., LLC, 18-CH-1329.
2. Pursuant to Paragraph III.J.1 of the Consent Order, and in recognition of the protections and requirements contained in the Consent Order, the February 15, 2019 Seal Order is hereby removed and rescinded effective at 10 a.m. (CST) on September 10, 2019.
3. The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency further authorizes Sterigenics U.S., LLC, to physically remove the posted Seal Orders from their facility.
