<b>Hardware:</b> ( includes snap hooks, carabiners, adjusters thimbles, and D-Rings) Inspect for damage, distortion, sharp edges, burns, cracks, corrosion and proper operation.	OK  Rejected	
<b>Webbing:</b> Inspect for cuts, burns, tears, abrasions, frays, excessive soiling and discoloration	OK  Rejected	
<b>Stitching:</b> Inspect for pulled or cut stitches	OK  Rejected	
<b>Labels:</b> Make certain labels are securely held in place and are legible.	OK  Rejected	
<b>Synthetic Rope:</b> Inspect for pulled or cut yarns, burns, knots, excessive soiling, and discoloration.	OK  Rejected	
<b>Energy Absorbing Component:</b> Inspect for elongation, tears, and excessive soiling.	OK  Rejected
