APPROVAL OF THE DU PAGE COUNTY WORKPLACE SAFETY AND PROPERTY  
LOSS CONTROL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, DuPage County strives to provide a safe campus for its employees and citizens; and

WHEREAS, safety cannot be viewed as an inconvenience or encumbrance to satisfactory job performance; and

WHEREAS, a Workplace Safety and Loss Control Program, including environmental health, has been developed using Illinois Department of Labor and Occupational Safety and Health Administration regulations, as well as best practices; and

WHEREAS, the program has been established to reduce and/or eliminate occurrences of loss, either personal injury or property while implementing preventative measures; and

WHEREAS, the County will utilize best practices to develop measures and monitor results to continuously improve the effectiveness of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the DuPage County Board that the Workplace Safety and Property Loss Control Program is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this program will be reviewed a minimum of annually and updated immediately upon notification of new regulations, or lessons learned to improve safety, fire prevention, environmental and health procedures; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Workplace Safety and Property Loss Control Program manual be made available to all employees via the County's intranet and through Personnel training.
