

Statement of Safety Policy

We are dedicated to providing a safe and healthful environment for our employees and visitors as well as preserving our property assets.

The employees of DuPage County are our most valuable asset. DuPage County will make reasonable efforts to comply with all Local, Federal and State regulations on the Environmental, Health, Safety and Property Loss Control.

Our Environmental Health, Safety and Property Loss Control program is intended to assist all employees in controlling hazards and risks which will help to prevent and reduce the number of injuries and property damage. Administration of the County's Loss Control Program is the responsibility of the Finance Department.

Safe operations will be a part of the day-to-day operations rather than a requirement to overcome. Safety cannot be viewed as an inconvenience or encumbrance to satisfactory job performance. Nothing we do is so important that it cannot be done safely.

Contractors performing work on County premises shall be required to comply with Local, State and Federal safety laws and regulations and to adopt safety practices equivalent to those applicable to County employees.

It is the employee's responsibility to follow safety rules established for their protection and the protection of visitors and to use personnel protection equipment provided. Employees also should ask their supervisors about any safety concerns they may have regarding their job responsibilities.

DuPage County is sincerely interested in our employee's and visitor's safety. Our policy is to provide a safe working environment, adequate tools, training and all necessary protective equipment.

The Board and Management staff of DuPage County values your personal safety and the importance to the overall Environmental, Health, Safety and Property Loss Control program.
