

This CD contains the following files:

- **Alert**
This is an MP3 file. IT **MUST** be in the same folder as the PowerPoint in order for you to play the outdoor warning siren sound on slide 3 of the presentation. If you do not want the siren sound to play on the animated version that you're using at a community event, simply remove the file from the folder where you save the presentation.
- **DuPage County Outdoor Warning System Model Policy and Guidelines**
This document contains the outdoor warning siren model policy, along with endorsement letters from the Emergency Management Coordinators' Association of DuPage (EMCAD), the DuPage County Chiefs of Police Association, the DuPage County Fire Chiefs' Association and Du-Comm
- **DuPage County Siren Presentation ANIMATED LOOP**
This is the same as the other PowerPoint that is on the CD, except that each slide is set to automatically advance after 30 seconds, and the presentation is set to start over after the last slide. This file is designed to be used if you are setting up a monitor at a community event, such as an outdoor festival, and you want to have the file playing in a continuous loop.
- **DuPage County Siren Presentation**
This is a PowerPoint presentation covers the basics of outdoor warning sirens and it also briefly discusses severe weather terms and information. This is a presentation that could be utilized on its own, or in conjunction with an emergency preparedness (Get a Kit, Make a Plan, Be Informed) presentation. The "notes" section of each slide contains a script that may be used in conjunction with the presentation
- **ReadyKids – Activity Book**
This is a printable activity book from FEMA
- **Severe Weather (2 PDF Files)**
One of these files is for color printing, the other is for black & white printing. Be sure to double-check your printer settings before printing multiple copies. You may need to go into your printer properties to enable double-sided printing, and to select “flip on short edge,” so that the flyer prints properly. You may also need to adjust your printer margins. If having the document professionally printed, be sure to see a proof before approving the order.
