ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 05

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE
WARRENVILLE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS,
PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION
OF A PUBLIC QUESTION TO LEVY A NEW TAX
FOR EMERGENCY AND RESCUE CREWS AND EQUIPMENT PURPOSES
TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF THE DISTRICT AT THE
CONSOLIDATED ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 2, 2019**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois (the "District") deems it advisable and in the best interests of the District and its residents to provide fully adequate fire prevention and protection, rescue, hazardous materials, emergency ambulance and other emergency services to or from points within the District; and

WHEREAS, the District continues to incur expenses for its emergency and rescue crews and equipment; and

WHEREAS, Section 24 of the Fire Protection District Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, 70 ILCS 705/24, provides in part:

§24. (a) In addition to any other tax authorized by law, the board of trustees of a fire protection district may, subject to the requirements of subsection (b) and (c), by ordinance levy a special annual tax at a rate not exceeding .10% of the value, as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue, of all taxable property within the district, for the purpose of obtaining funds to pay for the costs of emergency and rescue crews and equipment.

(c) Whenever the board of trustees of a fire protection district which levies a tax under this Section desires to increase the tax rate limit set forth under subsection (b), it shall certify the question to the proper election officials, who shall submit that question at an election to the voters of the district in accordance with the general election law. The result of such referendum shall be entered upon the records of the district. If a majority of the votes on the proposition are in favor of such proposition, the board of trustees may thereafter levy a special tax under this Section at a rate not to exceed .10% of the value of all taxable property within the district as equalized or assessed by the Department of Revenue. The proposition shall be in substantially the following form:

WHEREAS, the Board deems it advisable and in the best interests of the District and its residents to provide for additional funding to pay for the costs of emergency and rescue crews and equipment as permitted under Illinois law; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are not available for the foregoing purposes, and it is necessary and in the best interest of this District that the Board seek to levy a new tax rate for emergency and rescue purposes for the benefit of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District is subject to the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law of the State of Illinois, as amended ("PTELL"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 18-190 of PTELL, before the Board is authorized to levy a new tax for emergency and rescue purposes, the proposition of levying said new tax must be submitted to the voters of the District at a direct referendum under the provisions of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended ("Election Code"), and such proposition must be approved by a majority of the voters of the District voting on such proposition at an election to be held in and for the District, and it is hereby deemed advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the District that the proposition of levying said new tax for emergency and rescue purposes and having an additional tax of 0.10% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property in the District extended for such purpose, be submitted to the voters of the District at an election to be held and conducted in accordance with the general election law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the Board hereby finds that all the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are full, true, and correct and it shall incorporate them into this Ordinance by reference. The Board further finds that as of the date of the adoption

of this ordinance, the most recent levy year for which the limiting rate of the entire District is known is 2017.

Section 2: It is necessary and in the best interests of the District that a new tax for the purposes of funding emergency and rescue crews and equipment be established and that an additional tax of 0.10% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property in the District be extended for such purpose pursuant to Section 24(c) of the Fire Protection District Act.

Section 3: That the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters of the District at the Consolidated Election to be held on April 2, 2019, between the hours of 6:00 o'clock a.m. and 7:00 o'clock p.m. on said day (the "Election"):

Shall the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, be authorized to levy a new tax for emergency and rescue crews and equipment purposes and have an additional tax of .10% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein extended for such purposes?

Section 4: That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the DuPage County Election Commission of DuPage County (the "County"), for voters of the District at the Election.

Section 5: That either the DuPage County Election Commission or DuPage County Clerk (the "Election Authority") shall give notice of the Election (the "Notice") in accordance with the general election law in the Election Code by (i) publishing the Notice once not more than 60 days nor less than 10 days prior to the date of the Election in a local, community newspaper having general circulation in the District, and (ii) posting a copy of the Notice at least 10 days before the date of the Election at the principal office of the Election Authority.

Section 6: That not less than 10 days before the date of the Election, the Secretary of the Board shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the District.

Section 7: That it is hereby found and determined that *The Daily Herald* is a local community newspaper in and having general circulation in the District as required by Sections 12-4 and 12-5 of the Election Code.

Section 8: That the Notice shall appear over the name or title of the Election Authority and shall be substantially in the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the Consolidated Election to be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2019, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois:

Shall the Warrenville Fire Protection District, DuPage County, Illinois, be authorized to levy a new tax for emergency and rescue crews and equipment purposes and have an additional tax of .10% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein extended for such purposes?

[The following paragraphs are not part of the ballot question, but are to be printed on the ballot]

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$3,150,204, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$3,739,358.
- (2) For the 2019 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single-family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$33.33.

Section 11: That the Secretary of this Board to Trustees shall, not less than sixty-eight (68) days before the Election, certify to the Election Authority the proposition as hereinabove set forth to be submitted to the voters of the District at the Election. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Ordinance, and a certified copy of the Ordinance, and shall be substantially in the form of **EXHIBIT A** attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 12: That the Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and the time provided by law.


